Tue, July 11

This afternoon we board our motorcoach in Abilene and route to the DFW area to overnight in preparation for tomorrow's flight.

Wed, July 12 Warwick, RI

After breakfast we transfer to DFW Airport to board our flight to Boston and begin our tour of Cape Cod and More! Our chartered motorcoach will be waiting

to transfer us to Warwick, Rhode Island, a suburb of Providence. Rhode Island is the smallest of the 50 United States and was the first colony to declare independence from Britain and the last to ratify the Constitution, holding out until the Bill of Rights was added.

Thu, July 13

Warwick, RI

We take the short drive to Connecticut and spend the day in the village of Mystic. Historically, a leading seaport of the area, the story of Mystic's nautical connection is told at Mystic Seaport, the nation's largest maritime museum. The *Charles W Morgan*, built in 1841, is the last wooden whaleship in the world and has been permanently berthed at Mystic Seaport since 1941.

Fri, July 14

Hyannis, MA

Today we travel to Newport, which in the 1800's was a resort where the rich and famous came to vacation. A local guide will conduct a tour of the area including the famed Ocean Drive and the Bellevue Avenue mansion area. We will tour The

Breakers, a Vanderbilt mansion constructed between 1893 and 1895 as the summer home of Cornelius Vanderbilt II. Hyannis, MA


