Monday, October 29 Texarkana, AR

With the feel of autumn in the air we board our motorcoach to begin our tour to the mountains of Arkansas. Today's route will take us through the metroplex, where we will stop for lunch. This afternoon we make our way across East Texas and to our overnight destination of Texarkana.

A Park Interpreter will join our group for an afternoon tour through the state park where we will learn the Legend of Petit Jean and how the mountain received its name. At the conclusion of our Petit Jean Mountain exploration, we make our way to Mount Magazine State Park, our home for the next two nights. For those interested in a little night adventure, join us for star gazing from Arkansas's highest point.

Wednesday, October 31 Mount Magazine

You set the pace for your day. A schedule of

activities will be provided for you to choose any or ALL of the fun events while enjoying the majesty and beauty of the Lodge at Mount Magazine. Activities to choose from include; a tour of Mount Magazine State Park, afternoon of games at the lodge, lunch, lodge amenities, and evening entertainment.

Thursday, November 1 Yukon, OK

Just a few miles away from Mount Magazine, we stop for a visit at the Subiaco Abbey; a monastery established in 1887. Today the Abbey is home to 40 Benedictine monks in the Catholic Church serving God by prayer and work in the tradition of the Swiss-American Congregation. The Subiaco Academy, one of the nation's premiere college-prep boarding and day school academies is also located on the campus. Our next stop is just to the north at Wiederkehr Village. There we will tour one of the oldest and largest wineries and vineyards in mid-America and enjoy a tasting. Wiederkehr has produced wines since 1880, when Johann Andreas

Return Home

Before making our way back into the Lone Star State, you are in for a morning treat at the world famous Express Clydesdales. There we tour their beautiful and historical Clydesdale Barn (originally built in 1936 by H.I. Grimes, an Oklahoma City oilman and farmer) and see their majestic horses. Clydesdale are big, powerful, refined draft horses named after, and imported from, Clydesdale, Scotland. These gentle giants typically stand around 18 to 19 hands high and weigh nearly a ton. Today these Clydesdales travel across North American as ambassadors and help raise millions of dollars for Children’s Miracle Network Hospitals and other charities. This afternoon we make our way home after a tour filled with nature, history, new friends and memories that we will cherish for years to come.


