<u>Santa Fe, NM</u>

their crafts. You will have the option of visiting The Palace of the Governors (admission required). Built in 1610, it was the seat of government under Spanish, Native American, Mexican and U.S. territorial rule until 1909. Mid-afternoon we depart for Durango, CO.

Wed, Oct 8

<u>Durango, CO</u>

With eager anticipation this morning, we board the Durango and Silverton Narrow Gauge Train at the depot in Durango. The train travels 45.4 miles along the Animas River to Silverton while the train crosses the river 5 times en route. In Silverton, enjoy time for lunch and shopping in this former silver mining town with an elevation of 9318.

Thu, Oct 9

Farmington, NM

Heading to the west, our first stop will be Mesa Verde National Park, created in 1906 to protect some of the best preserved cliff dwellings in the world. Our visit will afford you great photo opportunities and a better understanding of the Ancestral Pueblo



people who made it their home. Leaving the park, we route to 4-Corners, the only point in the US where 4 states (Arizona, Colorado, New Mexico and Utah) come together at one place. Navajo artisans and vendors will be nearby selling jewelry and other crafts. We continue to Farmington, the commercial hub of northwestern New Mexico, to overnight.

<u>Fri, Oct 10</u>


<u>Albuquerque, NM</u>

Today we route to Albuquerque, the largest city in the state. The Rio Grande River runs through the city and the Sandia Mountains form a beautiful backdrop to the area. The word "Sandia" means watermelon in Spanish and the mountains glow a watermelon pink at sunset. The city will be filled with tourists in town for the 2025 Albuquerque International Balloon Fiesta's *Painted Horizons* and this evening we will attend the Balloon Glow followed by a spectacular fireworks display.

This morning we will rise early and transfer to the balloon grounds in anticipation of Mass Ascension, the



most photographed event in the world, with over 600 balloons going up in waves. Later today you will have time to enjoy Old Town Albuquerque and shop around the Plaza.
