Today we are ready for a full day of excitement starting with a visit to the Spencer Theatre. Opened in 1997, the theatre houses the largest private collection in the Southwest of Dale Chihuly, Seattle based artist. Chihuly's variegated glass sculptures, blazing with color and squirming with life, are considered the foremost glass art in the world. His amazing hand-blown creations are the only fine art to adorn the monumental Spencer Theater and his Glowing Sunset Tower is a 14-foot glass tower of squiggling bows of red and orange. The 564piece sculpture dominates the theater's Crystal Lobby. Lunch awaits us at the Ruidoso Downs before the horse racing begins. Ruidoso Downs hosts both Thoroughbred and Quarter Horse racing, notably the All American Futurity, the richest race in Quarter Horse racing. It also hosts the Grade 1 All American Derby in early September, which carries a purse of \$1,900,000 and was won in 2023 by Missouri-bred gelding, Whiskey Creek. This evening you will have free time for dinner on your own and perhaps try your luck at Inn of the Mountain Gods Casino. The premier resort and casino is located near Ruidoso, in Mescalero, and is owned by the Mescalero Apache Tribe.
