Sat, Aug 2 Tulsa, OK

senator, lived as a boy will be our first stop this morning and you will see John's bedroom which looks as it did when he was a child. Other displays include a 1/3 scale model of the Friendship 7 space capsule in which John Glenn took his historic flight in 1962. Arriving in the heart of Ohio's Amish Country, we will check in at the Carlisle Inn, our home for 3 nights. Dinner will be at Warther Carvings, where we view the priceless ebony and ivory steam engine carvings of the world's master carver, Mooney Warther.

Wed, Aug 6 Sugar Creek, OH

Holmes County, Ohio, is home to one of the largest Amish communities in the world, offering a rich and immersive experience into Amish life and culture. We begin to understand more of their history at the Amish and Mennonite Heritage Center to view the Cyclorama Mural, "Behalt." Next, we enjoy our free time and lunch on our own in the quaint town of Berlin. This afternoon you may choose to take in a matinee performance at the Ohio Star Theater or

We next head to Hershberger Bakery & Farmers Market. Be sure to meet Big King, the largest registered Belgium horse in Ohio. Tonight, experience dinner in an Amish home Learn more about Amish wedding customs and enjoy the bountiful family style feast!

Fri, Aug 8 Georgetown, KY

After our 3-day visit to the Amish Country of Ohio we turn to the south and route thru Cincinnati, located on the Ohio River. Cincinnati was the first major city to be founded after the American Revolution and the first major inland city in the country. Crossing the Ohio River we enter the "Blue Grass State" of Kentucky. This afternoon we will visit The Ark Encounter in Williamstown, Kentucky, where we will experience Bible history at the life-size Noah's Ark and enjoy an included lunch at Emzara's Kitchen.

Sat, Aug 9 Franklin, TN

We begin the day with a visit you will never forget as we make our way to Old Friends Farm, a retirement home for Thoroughbred Race horses. Here we learn of racing's royalty. Our next stop is at Keeneland. Known as a National Historic Landmark, Keeneland features beautifully landscaped grounds, home to spectacular Thoroughbred racing and the world's largest Thoroughbred auction company. We then cross into Tennessee where we will stay tonight in Franklin, just outside of Nashville.

Sun, Aug 10 Little Rock, AR

Heading west across Tennessee, we will again cross the Mississippi River, this time in Memphis. We will enjoy an included lunch in the "Home of the Blues." We route across Arkansas, a diverse state of mountains, delta and prairie, stopping for a rest break in the capital city of Little Rock, before

continuing into the "Lone Star State" of Texas.
