Albuquerque, NM

Grand Canyon National Park is one of the most beloved national parks with over 4.5 million visitors annually.

<u>Mon, September 15</u>

With the red rock formations behind us, we make our way south with a morning stop at Montezuma Castle National Monument. Montezuma Castle is a prehistoric Indian ruin nestled into a towering limestone cliff situated 75 feet up the cliff wall; one of the best-preserved cliff dwellings in North America. Our lunch will be at the Musical Instrument Museum, the only museum in the world devoted to global musical instruments, with some 5,000 on display at any given time. With your wireless headset that picks up signals transmitted from each exhibit you will hear the sounds of the instruments on display. We settle into our evening in Scottsdale, AZ, just steps away from Old Town Scottsdale

Tue, September 16

Tucson, AZ

Begin our day at the Desert Botanical Garden where you will embrace the magnificent beauty of the desert plants. Discover the tranquil vibrancy of 50,000 desert plants nestled amid the red rocks of the Papago Buttes. After our morning in the desert, we make our way to Tucson, AZ where we will enjoy an included lunch at Nation's Oldest Mexican Restaurant, El Charro. Afterward, with the assistance of a local guide, we will depart for a Tucson city tour with a stop at San Xavier del Bac Mission which was founded as a Catholic mission in 1692.

Wed, September 17

<u>Tucson, AZ</u>

This morning we explore nature's beautiful candelabras as we visit to Saguaro National Park with great photo opportunities. The Saguaro, a giant cactus, can live more than 200 years and sometimes grow to 50 ft high. Looking for a little more adventure? Up, up and away! An optional excursion is available for those interested in riding in an Hot Air Balloon over Tucson. You will coordinate your flight directly with a pre-selected company, who will provide hotel pick up/drop off. Ask Bilbrey Tours for additional information and cost. Our afternoon is at the unique world of miniatures as we visit the Mini Time Machine Museum. A collection of miniatures is housed in 3 main galleries: History, Exploring the World and Enchanted Realm. The stateof-the-art museum displays an array of antique and contemporary miniatures.

We start our journey east but not before stepping back in time with a morning stop in Tombstone, AZ - "The Town Too Tough to Die." Tombstone was made famous as a backdrop for so many of our favorite western shows. We will visit the OK Corral and be on the lookout for a gun-slinging shootout. Afterward, we set our sights on the Lone Star State, where we will stay the evening in El Paso.
